- 101 Louis Jadot, **Blanc**, Mâcon-Villages, Burgundy, France, 200921
This fresh, brilliant pale-gold Chardonnay shows delicate varietal aromas with flavors of apple and melon offset by citrus notes and a crisp acidic balance ending in a clean, lively finish.
- 102 Sonoma Cutrer, **Chardonnay**, "Russian River Ranches", Sonoma Coast, California, 2009.....24
Hints of minerality, along with apple, lime and a surprising kiss of strawberry.

Red Wines - Listed from milder to stronger

- 103 La Crema, **Pinot Noir**, Sonoma Coast, California, 2009.....24
Bright cherry, joined by plum, orange peel and tea leaves, giving a mouth-watering juiciness.
- 104 Clos du Bois, **Merlot**, North Coast, California, 200818
Blackberry, raspberry, plum, herbs and chocolate.
- 105 Kenwood Vineyards, **Cabernet Sauvignon**, Sonoma County, California, 2007.....18

- 201 Ruffino, Prosecco, Veneto, Italy, NV38
Crisp, clean and delicate with fine bubble caressing the palate. Intense sensations of apples and peaches drive a pleasant aftertaste, that is reminiscent of fruity and floral aromas.
- 202 Domaine Chandon, **Rosé**, California, NV42
Intense ripe strawberry, juicy watermelon, and fresh red cherry fruit aromas, mesh with flavors of apple, pear, and stone fruit.
- 203 Piper Sonoma, **Brut**, Sonoma County, California, NV34
Crisp and bright, opening with light yeast character, berry-apple fruit and faint vanilla. The wine has a creamy texture and exhibits subtle flavors of its classic grape varietals, with a lingering finish of citrus, berry and light toast.
- 204 Piper-Heidsieck, **Brut**, "Cuvée", Champagne, France, NV75
Lively and fresh with more mature of pineapple, nutmeg, white pepper and Oriental zest.
