SCHEDULED TOURS

DISCOVERY SERIES Nature Center

Come participate in our discovery series activities at the Nature Center. This class includes an educational activity and craft that highlights the topic of choice. Choose from Shark Discovery, Snake Discovery, Marine Mammal Discovery or Sea Turtle discovery. Ages 4 and up. \$20/person.

ECLIPSE PEDAL BOARD TOUR Walker's Landing

Experience our newest way of exploring the salt marsh. These innovative boards, similar to a stair stepper, use fins to propel you through the water and cover distance with ease. Ages 13 and up and at least 80lbs. \$70/person.

ECO BIKE HIKE Amelia's Wheels

Explore the resort's bike paths with a naturalist. Ages 6 and up. \$25/person.

ECOLOGY OF AMELIA Nature Center

On this island hopper tour, participants will learn the dynamics of the barrier island ecosystem. Limited availability. \$25/person.

FISHING 101 Nature Center

Learn how to bait a hook, make a cast and remove a fish from the hook during this one hour introductory level class. All tackle and bait is provided. Ages 4 and up. \$20/person.

NATURE KAYAK Walker's Landing

Paddle through the salt marsh as you learn about the local ecology and animals that call the marsh their home. \$65/person. Single kayaks available for ages 13 and up. Tandem kayaks for ages 8 and up with adult.

NATURE SEGWAY™ Amelia's Wheels

Explore the resort in style! This naturalist guided tour will lead you along paths covered by a Live Oak canopy, as you explore the marsh or the beach side of property. This is the perfect tour to learn about the diverse ecosystems that make up the island. Ages 8 and up (over 65lbs.) \$65/child & \$80-\$95/adult.

PADDLEBOARD ADVENTURE Walker's Landing

Geared towards all skill levels and includes an introductory paddle lesson. Ages 10 and up. \$65/ person.

ADVENTURE AMELIA Nature Center

Hike with a naturalist as you visit three bountiful ecosystems here on property. On this family focused tour, you will search for shark's teeth, examine trees in the maritime forest and explore the tidal salt marsh for keystone species and edible plants! \$150 for up to 5 people.

BARRIER ISLAND BIRDING Nature Center

Join a naturalist and search the local area for various species of native birds. Visit hot spots around the resort's property, then travel to Big and Little Talbot Island or Egans Creek Greenway for more discovery. Two hour tour. \$40/person.

BIRDS OF AMELIA Nature Center

Search for native and migratory birds, binoculars included. \$35/person.

CRAB GRAB Walker's Landing

Catch and learn about crabs, fish, and invertebrates that live in the marsh. Ages 4 and up. \$20/person.

JR. NATURALIST Nature Center

Experience the life of a Naturalist on Amelia Island. During this three hour class, participants will feed Nature Center animal residents, maintain aquariums and terrariums. Next, join our naturalists to help lead tours such as crab grab, fishing and our discovery series classes. \$75/child.

KAYAK FISHING/BASS FISHING Nature Center

Join our guide and visit the large mouth bass fishing holes. Participate via kayak or from the shore. All tackle is provided. Early morning or evening sessions are suggested. Ages 12 and up. \$120/person.

MARSH WALK Nature Center

Enjoy a leisurely walk through trails at Drummond Point Park. Limited availability. \$25/person.

SEA-COLOGY SEGWAY™ TOUR Amelia's Wheels

Join our naturalists on a tour highlighting the marvelous beaches of Amelia Island. Learn about the dynamic beach dune system that is home to many keystone species. \$95/person.
