ECOLOGY TOURS

BIRDS OF AMELIA | NATURE CENTER

Search for native and migratory birds, binoculars included. \$35/person.

ECO BIKE HIKE | NATURE CENTER

Explore the resort's bike paths with a naturalist. Ages 6 and up. \$35/person.

ECOLOGY OF AMELIA | NATURE CENTER

FAMILY EDUCATION SERIES

ADULT SHARK TOOTH | NATURE CENTER

Join a naturalist on our beach to find out more about sharks and learn tips on the best way to hunt for teeth! Tours include a shark guide and a bag for collecting teeth. Ages 13 and up. \$45/person.

DISCOVERY SERIES | NATURE CENTER

SEGWAY™ TOURS

CREEKSIDE & MARSHSIDE SEGWAY™ | AMELIA'S WHEELS

Everyone can go on this tour! Coached orientation is followed by a tour along our novice-level paths to Drummond Point Park or Walker's Landing. Ages 8 and up (over 65lbs.) \$70/child & \$85/adult.

NATURE SEGWAY™ | AMELIA'S WHEELS
