The Williamsburg Winery



Located on the historic 300-acre Wessex Hundred farm, The Williamsburg Winery was established in 1985 by the Duffeler family and released its first award-winning vintage, the Governor's White, in 1988.

In addition to the winery, The Williamsburg Winery is also home to a 28-room boutique hotel, Wedmore Place, as well as the Gabriel Archer Tavern and a Tasting Room in Colonial Williamsburg.

Matthew Meyer, Executive Vice President & Winemaker

Born in Great Britain, Matthew Meyer learned to appreciate wine from his father as they collected and enjoyed wines from around the world. It was this early passion for wine that took Matthew to the University of California at Davis, where he obtained a double degree in oenology and viticulture with a minor in business and marketing while also working part time in the Sierra Foothills and as a research assistant.



Matthew moved to Williamsburg in 2002 where he took the position of winemaker, and soon after was promoted to executive vice president, and is now a small share holder. In addition to making wine for The Williamsburg Winery Matthew also makes wine in Mendoza, Argentina, every year and along with his wife Elena have their own wine brand called "M". When not making wine Matthew consults for other wineries and gives lectures and seminars to many different organizations, both nationally and internationally.
