#### Odell Runoff Red IPA

Fort Collins, CO Red IPA 6.5% ABV 50 IBU  
16 oz: \$6.00 25 oz: \$8.00  
When it's spring in the Rockies, one day can span all four seasons. Morning snow gives way to afternoon sun, sending fresh snowmelt into our rivers and into our mash tun. With a complex malt backbone dry-hopped for notes of citrus and pine, it's almost as surprising as the season itself.

Tucson, AZ American Amber Ale 4.8% ABV

### Porters and Stouts

#### Guinness Extra Stout

Dublin, Ireland Irish Stout 5% ABV 41 IBU  
16 oz: \$7.00 25 oz: \$9.00  
Unmistakably Guinness beer, stout from the very first velvety sip to the last lingering drop, and every deep-dark satisfying mouthful in between! Pure Guinness

### Strong Ales

#### Founders Curmudgeon

Grand Rapids, MI Old Ale 9.8% ABV 50 IBU  
12 oz: \$7.00  
This old ale is brewed with molasses and an insane focus on the malt bill, then oak-aged. The result is a strong, rich, malty delight that's deceptively smooth and drinkable.

### Amber and Dark Lagers

#### Samuel Adams Boston Lager 12 oz: \$5.00

Boston, MA Vienna Lager 4.9% ABV 30 IBU  
Samuel Adams Boston Lager helped lead the American beer revolution, reviving a passion for full-bodied brews that are robust and rich with character.

### Wheat Beers

#### Bell's Oberon Ale 12 oz: \$6.00

Kalamazoo, MI American Wheat Ale 5.8% ABV 10 IBU  
Bell's Oberon is a wheat ale fermented with Bell's signature house ale yeast, mixing a spicy hop character with mildly fruity aromas.

#### Blue Moon Belgian White 12 oz: \$5.00

Golden, CO Witbier 5.4% ABV 9 IBU  
Brewed with oats and spiced with orange peel and coriander. An unfiltered wheat ale spiced in the Belgian tradition.

#### Samuel Adams Cold Snap 12 oz: \$5.00

Boston, MA Witbier 5.3% ABV 7 IBU  
Stirring from the haze of winter, this refreshing unfiltered White Ale awakens its smooth wheat with the bright snap of spring spices. From the subtle sweetness of orange peel and plum to the peppery bite of fresh ground coriander, the blend of spices creates just the right refreshing kick to signal that spring is on its way.

### Blonde and Pale Ales

#### \* Barrio Tucson Blonde 12 oz can: \$5.00

Tucson, AZ Blonde Ale 4.5% ABV  
An approachable, malt-oriented American beer that is well-balanced and great for easy-drinking.

#### Boulevard Tank 7 Farmhouse Ale 12 oz: \$7.00

Kansas City, MO Saison 8.5% ABV 38 IBU  
Beginning with a big surge of fruity aromatics and grapefruit-hoppy notes, the flavor of this complex, straw-colored ale tapers off to a peppery, dry finish.

### IPAs

#### \* Dragoon IPA 16 oz can: \$8.00

Tucson, AZ American IPA 7.3% ABV 85 IBU  
This is a true West Coast IPA-it is pale in color, with bracing bitterness, high alcohol content (about 7.3% abv) and a fruity/floral/citrus hop aroma.

#### Stone Delicious IPA 12 oz: \$6.00

Escondido, CA American IPA 7.7% ABV 80 IBU  
This intensely citrusy, beautifully bitter beer is worthy of the simple-yet-lordly title of Stone Delicious IPA.

### IPAs

#### \* Tower Station 16 oz can: \$8.00

Flagstaff, AZ American IPA 7.3% ABV 70 IBU  
Mother Road Brewing Co. Unfiltered IPA with tangerine & pineapple aromas and Pilsner & Pale malts with flavors of grapefruit & pine.

### Amber, Red, and Brown Ales

#### Dogfish Head Indian Brown Ale 12 oz: \$5.00

Milton, DE American Brown Ale 7.2% ABV 50 IBU  
Indian Brown Ale is a cross between a Scotch Ale, an IPA, and an American Pale. This beer is well hopped and malty at the same time.

#### Left Hand Sawtooth Nitro Ale 12 oz: \$3.00

Longmont, CO Extra Special Bitter (ESB) 5.3% ABV 27 IBU  
SUPER SMOOTH NUTTY MALT FLAVORS  
BALANCED BY HERBAL HOPS.

### Porters and Stouts

#### Odell Lugene Chocolate Milk 12 oz: \$4.00

#### Stout

Fort Collins, CO Sweet Stout 8.5% ABV 35 IBU  
This full bodied, creamy, smooth milk stout is rich with milk and dark chocolates. The dark malts provide a balance to the sweetness of the rich chocolate. Warming from the alcohol, this is a great dessert beer like a chocolate liquor.

### Sour and Fruit Beers

#### Founders Rübæus 12 oz: \$6.00

Grand Rapids, MI Fruit Beer 5.7% ABV 15 IBU  
Optimizing the flavor of fresh raspberries, Rübæus is Founders' way of celebrating the joys of summer year-round. This stunning berry-red masterpiece is the perfect blend of sweet, tart and refreshing.

### Ciders and Meads

#### Angry Orchard Crisp Apple Cider 12 oz: \$5.00

Cincinnati, OH Fruit Cider 5% ABV 7 IBU  
This crisp and refreshing cider offers sweet apple notes up front with a subtle dryness at the finish for a balanced cider taste.
